



Mansfield BID Business Crime Partnership is a long standing, successful, productive and effective intelligence led organisation that brings together business across a 24 hour economy within Mansfield Town Centre. It's aims and objectives are to reduce crime and disorder, and the fear of crime which can have a negative impact on the business community, including all those who work, live, visit and invest in the City.

It is an active member of the Nottinghamshire wide scheme known as PABCIN (Partners Against Business Crime In Nottinghamshire). The county scheme brings most of the business crime reduction Partnerships in each town centre across Nottinghamshire together. It will include all schemes such as pub watch and shop watch within the County. Information is collated from across the county and shared between town and city centre's locally and regionally.

Mansfield BID Business Partnership is a not for profit making organisation which is funded by its members, run for the benefit of business by business and is totally independent but works closely with partners including Nottinghamshire Police in order to achieve its objectives which it delivers both on a strategic and operational level.

- Access to shared intelligence and information locally, countywide, regionally and nationally
- Analysis of trends, patterns, and activities for management purposes
- Participation in a number of Exclusion Schemes
- Access to a radio link shared by the BCRP, Police, CCTV and business
- Fortnightly intelligence and security briefings
- Representation by the BCP on various forums
- Various training packages
